ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Participation in at least one (1) Women's Committee meeting, event, or charity drive during the previous calendar year
- Enrolled or planning to enroll in an undergraduate, graduate, trade, technical, or vocational program
- Teamster member in good standing

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

2. Submit a typed essay of 500 words or less on the topic below
3. Forward the completed application and essay to your local union for verification of membership

How will your educational goals help you contribute to the workforce your community, or the labor movement?”
